Date	Summary of Events SECRET
13/5/44	Attack on the marshalling yard of Tourcoing - Leader of formation is F/O Allegret - W/C Gorri advises crew to be very careful as target is situated near populated area. Bombing is very good and later Air Vice Marshall commanding No 2 Group sends telegram of congratulations.
	In the afternoon 6 a/c.take off lead by F/O Langer - Target is railway communication at Douai - Weather conditions are rather poor Bombing results of the first box are good but a little short for the second .
14/-5/44	Early call at 4 h 30 - Operation is cancelled before taking off - Later parade is held of all personnel and the Wing Commander, passes a review.
15/5/44	12 aircraft take off lead by W/C Gorri for an operation on Mezieres Charleville - Fighter escort does not appear at rendezvous and formation turns back home without bombing. In the afternoon a briefing is announced for 17 h 45 - As formation is ready to take off it is cancelled. No operational activity - Training flights - Squadron is now under canvas.

Operation is carried out on No Ball of Behen –Leader is P/O Fortin - Flak is heavy - On the return aircraft belonging to F/O Howard has difficulty in
landing. his landing gear having been hit by flak. However he lands safely.
Early call - Target is No Ball at Bois Cocquerel - 12 a/c lead by F/L Garot.
Take off - Fog is over target - First box bombs through a hole but 2 nd is unable to bomb. Results are unknown.
No operational activity - Lecture by the W/CO. in the morning and stand down in the afternoon.
No operational activity in the morning. However 4 boxes take off at 19 H 00 leaded by W/O Maher - Target is engine shed at Douai - A little flak is encountered near Dunkirk - Bombing results are very good - Evasive actions on return to avoid flak.
In the afternoon 24 aircraft (12 belonging to 342 Squadron, and 12 to 88 Squadron,) take off lead by W/C Gorri - Target is the airfield of Dinard - Visibility is excellent and target is identified a long way - Results are very good. Runways and dispersals are hit. No enemy opposition.
In the morning 4 new crews are posted to 342 Squadron. A formation of 24 aircraft take off lead by 88 Sqaudron - Target is the airfield of Evreaux - Light flack encountered over area of Elbeuf - Good bombing results. In the afternoon a formation takes off leaded by F/O Allegret – Target is XX the airfield of Seclin near Lille - Visibility is very poor - However, target is found and bombed by several aircraft whilst the others keep their bombs.
Merville is then bombed on the return and good results are scored - Several aircraft are hit by flak.
In the morning 18 aircraft take off leaded by 88 Squadron. Target is the airfield of Thiery north of Valenciennes - Bombing results are good in spite 7/10 of cloud - In the afternoon training of 4new crews is carried out. Arrival of French writer and reporter J Kessel.
Briefing at 11 H 30.Low Level training flying for four crews.
F/O Andlauer receives officially the DFC by British authorities for part played in bringing his aircraft back to base.
During the day two lectures are given, one concerning night flying.
One more lecture on night flying is given by F/O Allegret and P/O Sovver. Projection-of films taken during recent bombings.
No activity - Crews prepare for night flying, which is later cancelled.
Briefing for smoke screen flight.
Training flight with smoke laying .
Important declaration at crew room made by Wing Commander.
Mechanics receive orders for painting white stripes on aircraft.
Constitution of battle order (12 crews for emergency and 12 crews in reserve).
Breakfast is at 1.30 Hours Briefing at First French Crew ff at 5 H 10 in view of laying smoke between the invasion forces and the French coast. Aircraft take off every ten minutes.
One of our aircraft is missing Operations are successful.
